

DISCUSSION GUIDE FOR SMALL GROUPS 14 & 15 AUGUST 2021

BREAD TALK

Scripture: John 6:47-59

- **Begin by reading the Scripture passage together. Review the video of the sermon if needed (see <http://www.brnc.org.sg/category/resources/sermons>).**
- **Use the following questions as a guide for your group discussion. Feel free to discuss as few or as many as best fits your group's current context and present stage in life.**
- **Remember to budget some time (15-20 min) to pray with and for one another, before ending your group session.**

1) Share in your group: how often do you read the Bible and pray? How often do you *want* to read the Bible and pray? Pray for one another, that God would enlarge our desire for Him and our delight in Him.

2) The sermon spoke of the sacramentality of ordinary life.

a) What are the modern symbols of God sustaining us and giving us life? These may be objects, events, or practices.

b) How can you prepare your heart in belief and trust before partaking of Holy Communion?

3) What are the good things in our lives that we cling to even more so than to Jesus? What action or changes will you make in your life to feast on Jesus even in the everyday?
