

DISCUSSION GUIDE FOR SMALL GROUPS 11 & 12 SEPTEMBER 2021

THE LIVING WORD OF GOD

Scripture: Hebrews 1:1-3

- **Begin by reading the Scripture passage together. Review the video of the sermon if needed (see <http://www.brmc.org.sg/category/resources/sermons>).**
 - **Use the following questions as a guide for your group discussion. Feel free to discuss as few or as many as best fits your group's current context and present stage in life.**
 - **Remember to budget some time (15-20 min) to pray with and for one another, before ending your group session.**
- 1) God spoke "in many and various ways". Can you name some of the genres found in Scripture, giving relevant examples? (E.g. genre of prophecy: Isaiah). How can you tune your ears to listen well and pay better attention to the different genres of Scripture?
 - 2) The sermon spoke of God's grand narrative and plan revealed across the different portions of the Bible. Could you summarise this grand narrative to one another in your group? How about if a seeker or a newer Christian asked you about it, how would you explain it to them?
 - 3) Are you struggling with having a regular, consistent, daily diet of Scripture? Do you agree with the sermon that it's not just about willpower but about hunger? How will you pray for, encourage, and support one another in this regard?
 - 4) "When the living Word speaks, things happen". Do you think and feel like you can rely on this truth? Share with your group why, or why not.
