KOINONIA

Scripture: Nehemiah 4:7-20

- **Begin by reading the Scripture passage together. Review the video of the sermon if needed (see <http://www.brnc.org.sg/category/resources/sermons>).**
 - **Use the following questions as a guide for your group discussion. Feel free to discuss as few or as many as best fits your group's current context and present stage in life.**
 - **Remember to budget some time (15-20 min) to pray with and for one another, before ending your group session.**
- 1) Ps Wendy spoke of many in our church community who have become increasingly disconnected over the past couple of years. On a scale of 1 to 10, how connected are you to the BRMC community? What actions could you personally take to move upwards along the scale and move towards rebuilding true community? Will you commit to doing this in 2022?

 - 2) The text of Nehemiah describes a people who pressed on despite opposition from various fronts, who remained watchful and prepared amidst their labour. The sermon reminded us of the need to be prepared in prayer. How has your prayer life been these past few months? Is the Lord calling you to a renewed watchfulness in prayer in 2022? Is the Lord reminding you that He is the One who fights for you (4.20)? What will you do, individually and as a small group, to stay prepared through prayer in 2022?
