GUIDELINES FOR FAMILIES

WORSHIP POSTURE

- Let your children know that the service time and space are sacred, unlike their home, playground, or school
- Teach them the right posture before God,
 e.g. to raise their hands during songs, and to join in what others are doing
- Remind them to be considerate of others during the service



TOYS AND ACTIVITY SHEETS

- Bring toys that are soft or padded, if needed.
 (Hard items will echo throughout the Sanctuary when knocked or dropped)
- Prepare activity sheets to keep your children busy during the service*



CRY ROOM

- If your children have meltdowns, fuss or make loud noises every 3-5 minutes, please bring them outside to the Cry Room
- Do return to the Sanctuary as soon as they have settled down
