Text: Hebrews 10:19-31
Title: The Essential Community
Date: 29–30 April 2023

A. Sermon Recap (20 mins)

1. Invite participants to take turns to read the biblical text aloud. If time permits, read the text again after a time of silent reflection.
2. Is there something in the text/sermon that particularly touched or troubled you?
3. What would be the main lesson for you from the sermon?

B. Transformation Questions (60 mins)

1. According to the preacher, God kept us alive on earth because “there is work to be done, a person to become, and an adventure to experience.” Share which of these three aspects resonated with you most, and why.
2. Is your CG a place where people know about your sins and struggles, fears and failures, and still love you for who you are? In other words, is your group one where you don’t just hear the Good News of Jesus Christ, but experience it first-hand? Share honestly how you feel.

3. If we are serious about our faith, we should welcome accountability—for accountability is God’s gift to us so that God doesn’t have to judge us Himself (cf. Heb. 10:30–31). What would you like your group members to keep you accountable for until you next meet?

4. It was reported that in Wesley’s class meetings, “the weak have been made strong; the bowed down have been raised up; the tempted have found delivering grace; the doubting mind has had all its doubts and fears removed, and the whole class have found that this was ‘none other than the house of God, and the gate of heaven’” (Peter Cartwright, 19th Century Methodist preacher). As an encouragement to each other, share how your CG has been a blessing to you in similar ways.

C. Prayer (10 mins)

1. Pray for one another, that we would be empowered by the Spirit to live out specific areas of transformation raised during CG time.
2. Pray for personal needs shared, as well as for our church, our nation, and our world as the Lord leads.
