On Predestination

These Children's Materials are inspired by John Wesley's sermon. The intention is for both adults and children to be studying similar Bible materials at the same time, to facilitate family discussion. These suggested materials are therefore meant to help plan the children's programme of intergenerational connect groups.

You can use these materials to plan for a children's programme of 50-60 mins (excluding worship, prayer etc). The basic components are as follows –

Bible Story/ Stories

Discussion

Activities/ Games

It is important for all facilitators to pray and prepare before the 'lesson' proper. The 'lesson' is only the beginning. May you continue to walk with the children, especially your own, over these materials after the 'lesson'.

SUMMARY

For children to know that God has plans for every child to become a believer in the God who knows everything. When they become children of God, they are made right with God and will become more and more like Jesus.

GOALS FOR CHILDREN

- 1. When they believe in Jesus and become children of God, they are made right with God (justification).
- 2. To trust God to help them become more and more like Jesus (sanctification). It is a process done by God.
- 3. To understand God is eternal (7-12yo).

On Predestination

A. Bible Story

Use the children's personal Bible to share the Bible verse. Romans 8:29-30

God knew them before he made the world. And God chose them to be like his Son. Then Jesus would be the firstborn of many brothers. God planned for them to be like his Son. And those he planned to be like his Son, he also called. And those he called, he also made right with him. And those he made right, he also glorified. (International Children's bible)

For from the very beginning God decided that those who came to him—and all along he knew who would—should become like his Son, so that his Son would be the First, with many brothers. And having chosen us, he called us to come to him; and when we came, he declared us "not guilty," filled us with Christ's goodness, gave us right standing with himself, and promised us his glory. (Living Bible)

- It is suggested to use the International Children's Bible for 4-6yo and the Living Bible for 7-12yo.
- <u>Predestination</u> is a big term, which means God knows who will become His children. It
 is in <u>God's plan</u> that these are the ones who will respond to His love and who will be
 saved from their sin.
- God is <u>eternal</u> and <u>all-knowing</u>. He exists outside of time, so He sees the past, the present and the future. Therefore, God knows and sees the heart of every man.
- It is wrong to say that since God knows and plans, the choice to become God's children
 or not is God's alone and not ours also. Everyone must be responsible for his or her
 own choice of whether he or she will become God's child or God's enemy (not God's
 child).

- When we become children of God, God says that we are 'not guilty' of our sins because
 Jesus paid the price of sin by dying on the Cross. This is called <u>justification</u>. We become
 righteous, made right with God.
- God will also make us more and more like Jesus. This is called <u>sanctification</u>, which is a process of walking God's way that will end only when we die.
- All these happen because of the <u>grace</u> of God and <u>faith</u> in God. Grace is favour from God that we don't deserve. Faith is trusting and believing that Jesus is our Saviour, who saves us from our sins by dying on the Cross.

B. Discussion

- For the primary school children (7-12yo), spend more time in discussion with them to clear their doubts. The section of activities/ games is shorter for them in this lesson.
- Predestination, justification and sanctification may be difficult for children of 7-12yo to fully understand. Even those who have been God's children for many years may not grasp everything. It is normal to face questions from the children that you cannot answer. Be honest with them that you don't have the answer and you will find an answer and get back to them.
- Encourage those children who are struggling to understand predestination, justification
 and sanctification by admitting that these are tough things to understand. Ask the
 children to pray to God to help them understand predestination, justification and
 sanctification better.
- For those who are not yet children of God and would want to become one, get the
 resource from Iris and pass the resource to the parents. Leave the privilege of bringing
 the child to Christ to the parent. If the child is not comfortable to receive Christ under
 the guidance of the parent, you as the facilitator can bring the child to Christ by saying
 the sinner's prayer with the child. Remember to inform the parents of their child's
 salvation.

C. Activities/ Games

Materials Needed

- Appendix 3.3 Character of God (Jesus)
- Appendix 3.4 What is Jesus like?
- Black whiteboard markers, red coloured marker, scissors, coloured pencils, pencils, pens, tape, paper clips, plastic sheets and wet wipes and 2 large strips of paper.

For 4-6yo

- Place a plastic sheet over Appendix 3.1 picture of boy and girl, secure plastic sheet and paper together with a paper clip. Then ask the children to use the black whiteboard marker to colour black over the boy or the girl, depending on the gender of the child. Tell the children, this is everyone before he or she becomes a child of God. We are sinful, meaning we do things that God says are wrong. The black ink covering the boy or girl represents the sinfulness of the person.
- When we believe in Jesus and become children of God, God removes our sins and forgives them. Use a piece of wet wipe to remove the black ink. We are made right with God and are 'not guilty' of our sins.
- Ask the children to draw a cross over the boy or the girl using a red marker. For the younger children (4-5yo), an adult's help may be needed to draw the Cross. The cross represents the death of Jesus on the Cross. We are made right with God because of Jesus' death on the Cross. Jesus pays for our sins on the Cross. This is called justification. It is done when we believe in Jesus and become children of God.
- Ask the children what they like about Jesus. Appendix 3.3 has a list of God's character and its meaning as reference. Use Appendix 3.2 Grow to be more like Jesus. Fold on the line that separates the body and the legs, and fold upwards to shorten the body. Tell the children that they can pray to God to help them be more

like Jesus, to be what they like about Jesus. Pull at the leg to unfold the paper to show the growing of the body. The body is divided into 7 parts. Get the children to colour one part of the body. Tell the children to bring the paper home, to colour one part each day of the week till the whole person is coloured.

 Pray that God will help each child know that when he or she becomes a child of God, he or she will be made right with God. Pray that God will help the child to know that he or she is also slowly becoming more like Jesus, with the help of God.

For 7-12yo

- Use Appendix 3.4 What is Jesus like. Ask the children to fill in the column under Jesus what they know about Jesus. Appendix 3.3 has a list of God's character and its meaning as a reference. For the younger children (7-8yo), an adult's help may be needed to fill in the table.
- Then ask the children which of the character of Jesus they would like to have in themselves, to be like Jesus. Ask children to put a tick under the 'Me' column for the character that they wanted. For the younger children (7-8yo), an adult's help may be needed to fill in the table.
- Pray that God will help each child know that when he or she becomes a child of God, he or she will be made right with God, 'not guilty' anymore. Pray that God will help the child know that he or she is also slowly becoming more like Jesus, with the help of God.

Extra activity for 7-12yo

- This activity is to explain to the children that God is eternal. This can be done with younger children (4-6yo) but simpler age-appropriate language should be used.
- Use two strips of paper that are large enough for all the children to see.
 - Make a loop with one strip of paper and tape it together. (A)
 - With the other strip of paper, make a loop too. Before taping it together, turn one end 180 degrees and tape it (half-turn). The final product looks like an infinity sign. (B)
- Pick up loop A and ask. "How many sides does this have?"
- Ask a child to come forward with a marker and colour one side of the loop.
- Tell the children that only one side of the loop is coloured and one side is not. Loop A has 2 sides.
- Take loop B and ask the children, "How many sides do you think this loop has?"
- Ask another child to come forward with a marker. Instruct the child to use marker to
 make a path in the middle of the loop. Continue to mark a line down the middle of
 the loop until the marker is back where it started.
- Ask the children, "Can they find the side that has no marks?" (Every part of the loop has a mark on it. Loop B has 1 side only.)
- Loop A is like us. We have a body and a soul/ spirit. Ask the children, "Which part of us will live forever?" (The answer is soul/ spirit.)
- Loop B is like God. God is spirit and lives forever. God is eternal, exists outside of time. God does not have a side or a part of Him that will die some day.


